Admissions Policy

The training is open to men and women who have demonstrated personal suitability for training based on maturity of personality, integrity of character, intellectual creativity, and aptitude for psychological insight and understanding. Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree, although exceptions may be made based on a personal interview and letters of reference. Non-degree students* will be automatically given probationary status. Applicants will be notified in writing as to their enrollment status. Once enrollment reaches its maximum, applicants will be put on a waiting list. A course may be cancelled if enrollment does not reach a minimum number.

Tuition and Fee Schedule:

Application	\$75	Accompanies application
Enrollment Deposit	\$200	Due within 30 days of acceptance
Tuition	\$8,500	1/3 due by the first day of class. Paid in full by August 2017
AMI Membership	\$75/year \$95/year non-US residents	Due each summer
Practicum fee	\$150	Due September, 2017
Exam fee	\$200	Due May, 2018

One third is due on the first day of class. After that, a monthly schedule can be arranged if needed. All fees must be paid in full by the end of the second summer. Students should also budget for miscellaneous expenses, travel, lodging, books, and materials. The amount spent will vary among individuals.

Course Calendar

The 2016–2018 course will require six weeks attendance the first summer, eight weeks the second summer, and four weeks attendance the third summer. Classroom observation and student teaching must be fulfilled during the interim winter periods.

With the successful passing of comprehensive written and oral examinations, the course culminates in graduation the third summer and the awarding of the coveted AMI diploma.
